Supervisor Steve Grimm called the regular meeting of the Cannon Township Board to order at 7:00 pm. Clerk Deb Diepenhorst offered the invocation.

Motion by Kim McKay, supported by Jim Alles, to approve the Agenda and the Consent Agenda with the addition of Check Register #13723 - #13747. Roll call vote: Brod-yes, Davies-yes, Diepenhorst-yes, Grimm-yes, McKay-yes, Spencer-yes, Alles-yes. Ayes-7, Nays-0. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

1) Bailey FOIA Appeal – 2018-16 (Grimm)

Mr. & Mrs. Don Bailey sent in their payment for FOIA Invoice #2018-16. Included on their invoice was their response dated 6/12/18 Appeal/Notice stating that full and complete copies of all existing and requested information was not provided. Their request was not denied. Mr. Grimm stated, he followed up to verify that the Township provided the information as requested. Mr. Grimm also stated that the Township does not concede there was any denial of their FOIA requests because the Township provided all the public records requested. The following motion was offered.

Motion by Deb Diepenhorst, supported by Jim Alles, to deny the appeal from Mr. & Mrs. Don Bailey. Voice vote: Ayes-7, Nays-0. Motion carried.

Water Update: Mr. Grimm noted that the water in Cannon Township is still fine. He understands the Tannery will be undergoing the installation of charcoal filters. This will filter all the water out of the Tannery and the river. They asked if the North Kent Sewer Authority could accept that water. This would be acceptable as long as they can establish that there is no PFAS.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

1) Road Committee (Alles) Mr. Alles spoke with DeYoung Concrete and West Michigan Tree Service about the tree problem on Cristo Drive. To replace two concrete sections would be about \$500.

2) Planning Commission (Brod) The Dollar General (Ramsdell/Belding Road) was approved. The Planning Commission voted to forward the PUD rezoning of Belding Road and Courtland to the Board for approval.

3) Information Technology Committee (McKay) They talked about our existing website. Ms. McKay will set up a meeting to discuss the website and some training with the IT Committee.

4) Sewer Committee (Diepenhorst) Per Prein & Newhof the sewer lining pre-construction meeting for Lake Bella Vista is set for 9:00 am on July 13.

Diepenhorst – The solicitation permit for Southwestern Advantage Books was revoked due to complaints from residents.
