Supervisor Steve Grimm called the regular meeting of the Cannon Township Board to order at 7:00 pm. Trustee Dick Davies offered the invocation.

1) NKSA Update (Grimm) They will be meeting to discuss whether to hook up to Bella Vista water for the Grass Lake Lift Station.

2) Planning Commission Update (Brod) The Orchard View preliminary site-plan was approved at the Planning Commission level. The next step will be Board approval.

3) Recreation Committee (McKay) The dirt/grass at the Bostwick Lake Park will be removed and replaced with beach sand this fall. Ms. McKay, Ms. Diepenhorst and Scott Post, Prein & Newhof, will be meeting (Thursday 8:30 am) with a property owner about the proposed trail for next year. Mr. Grimm asked the Recreation Committee to review a proposal from West MI Tree Service for trail maintenance (\$59,000). Ms. McKay indicated the committee is not in favor of moving ahead with the proposal. Mr. Grimm asked the Recreation Committee and West MI Tree Service be invited to the next Board meeting to discuss the proposal.

4) Road Committee (Alles) He is still working on the tree issue on Cristo Drive. The KCRC is working on cutting limbs hanging over the road at Courtland Dr.
