2) ORDINANCE NO. 2018-3 – Gate Ordinance Revision (Grimm)

An analysis was provided reflecting parcels larger than eight acres. Several Board members felt that ten acres rather than eight acres was more appropriate.

Motion by Terry Brod, supported by Kim McKay, to adopt ORDINANCE 2018-3 an Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 2015-6, pertaining to Residential Access Gates with the following changes: 8 acres to 10 acres and a typo in Section 5 (a) “presents” should be “prevents”. Voice vote: Ayes-5, Nays-2 (Davies, Diepenhorst). Motion carried.
